Directions from Pink Hill via HWY 11: Turn at the gas station onto HWY 241. Take a Left at stop light onto Potter's Hill Rd. (also gas station). Go about 4.3 mi., turn Left onto Mary Tate Rd. Go about 1.3 miles and we are the first house on the left after the second bridge. Black Mailbox #1712 across from driveway.

Directions from Beulaville via HWY 24: At the intersection of HWY 24 and 41/241 in Beulaville (stoplight), turn North on HWY 241 N/41 E/ 111 N (Left if coming from Kenansville on HWY 24 East). Go about 6.1 mi. on 241 N, turn Right at the golf course onto Country Club Rd. Go straight through two stop signs, crossing Sumner Rd. and Potter's Hill Rd (Country Club Rd. will become Mary Tate Rd.). Go about 1.3 miles and we are the first house on the left after the second bridge. The black mailbox #1712 across from the driveway.

Directions from Raleigh: I-40 East to Exit 373 (Rose Hill Magnolia), Go up the off ramp and turn Left onto HWY 903 (Kenansville bypass). Follow the signs to Beulaville. Veer right before stoplight onto 24 East. Then, follow the directions from Beulaville.
